Clinics:

Summer Clinic in Mid Michigan June 12/13. Info on website. Last year we had about 70 kids. Evaluations will be updated to the new codes, rules and skills.

Elite Camp on June 18-20, hosted by Branch. Location to be determined by Al
Inviting all level 10 and level 9s in age. Top 6 level 7s plus alternates. We want 36 kids.
We don't want to invite 5s and 6s at this point. Ideally from each level (7, 9 in age, 10)we
would want 12 gymnasts. Cost is 85\$ per gymnast. Change name of event to Optional
Skills Clinic, or away from the elite name. Opening camp to level 6, 8 and 9 year olds.

Shawn will be asking for coaches for the clinics as we get closer to the event.

We need to get our state gymnasts in age for each level. ie at level 6 the gymnast should
be 8 years old.

Tony asked, do we need more camps since a lot of kids don't/cant attend just the one
state/elite clinic. Shawn replied that we need to do more to just push our kids to get into
age for their level and to really play up the clinics. We have 3 clinics, state/elite/fall(future
stars)

Anyone can go to the future stars clinics and can pick the age group they want to do, but
only the ones in the right age group can go to regional future stars. Opening up the option
for 12 year olds to work the 10 year old future star routines still allows for the gymnast to
work future stars without having to do the harder in age routines that they maybe can't do,
which will hopefully increase the attendance of the camp. Future Stars programs have to
that really aren't being used since the mentality is that future stars are ONLY for the elite
the elite, so it tends to get skipped over.

We need to push responcebility to get gymnasts in age to the clubs, get the coaches to
change something in their programs to get their kids in the levels to their age.

Future star age groups changed to color groups instead of ages for the state to encourage
clubs to use the routines as additional tools to train all gymnasts. Opposed to saying that
you aren't in age you shouldn't be doing FS
